Notice of Call for Bids is hereby given by the State of Wyoming, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Abandoned Mine Land Division (AML), Cheyenne, Wyoming, for a general contract that consists of the rotary drilling and as necessary the pressure injection of low to moderate slump grout into mine voids, workings, and rubblized zones within the confines of Skyline Village Manufacture Housing Community, which is located on the northeast periphery of Rock Springs, Wyoming, and just immediately northeast of Interstate 80 and designated as AML 6A-7-19, Skyline Village Manufactured Housing Community, Phase IX. This project is funded in whole or in part with a grant from the Department of Interior, CFDA 15.252. **The work on this Project is anticipated to begin in May, 2010.**

The estimated cost of the work is \$1,500,000.00 - \$2,500,000.00

Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 P.M. on the 1st day of April, 2010 at the Department of Administration and Information, Procurement Section, 122 West 25th Street, Herschler Building, 2nd Floor East, Cheyenne, WY 82002.

Please respond to each individual bid with either submission of bid, or notice, **in writing**, (phone request will not be accepted) stating that you are unable to bid on this particular project but wish to remain on the active bidders mailing list for AML projects. Failure to respond will be understood by the Department to indicate lack of interest and concurrence in the removal of your firm's name from the active AML bidders mailing list.

A certified check or bid bond in the sum of ten percent (10%) of any bid must be filed with said bid, to be forfeited to the State of Wyoming as liquidated damages, if the bidder is awarded the proposed contract and fails to enter into a contract with AML.

The successful bidder must furnish Performance and Payment bonds guaranteeing the faithful performance of the contract and the payment of labor and materials thereunder. Said bonds are to be in the sum of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price and in substance, form, and execution shall be approved by the State of Wyoming, Attorney General's Office.

QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS: Each Bidder must be prequalified by the Wyoming DEQ/AML prior to receiving a bid proposal from the Engineer. A prequalification package is immediately available from the Engineer's office. Completed prequalification questionnaires are due to V. Zimmerman at the DEQ/AML Lander office, 510 Meadowview Drive, Lander, Wyoming 82520 and must be received by 5:00 p.m. March 12, 2010.

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AML may make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work and the bidder shall promptly furnish to AML all such information and data for this purpose as AML may request. If the bidder does not supply such information to AML, AML may determine the bidder is unresponsive and may disqualify the bidder.

The Bidders' Tour of the Project will be convened at 10:00 A.M. on March 3, 2010 at Rock Springs City Hall, Downstairs conference room, 212 "D" Street, Rock Springs, Wyoming. Notice is hereby given that attendance at the Bidders' Tour for the Project is **MANDATORY** for all prospective bidders. **The State will reject bids submitted from any bidder who failed to attend the Bidder's Tour, in its entirety. The State will reject bids from any BIDDER who has not signed the attendance sheet prior to the commencement of the tour briefing or who departs from the tour before the tour is declared adjourned by the design ENGINEER conducting the tour. Bidder must also sign out on the attendance sheet.**

The purpose of the tour is to familiarize all bidders with the various locations and aspects of the Work and to allow prospective bidders to ask questions concerning the Work. The Bidder's Tour, however, does not relieve bidders from the responsibility of familiarizing and informing themselves of the extent and character of the Work as required by the Contract Documents. **If weather forces postponement of the Bid Tour, the Engineer will notify plan holders of new date and time.**

Questions may be directed to the ENGINEER outside the bid tour; however, they must be in writing. ENGINEER shall respond in writing, sharing the request and response with all plan holders of record. No questions shall be responded to after March 12, 2010.

All bids shall be opened and the total of each bid read by the State of Wyoming, Department of Administration and Information, Procurement Section, on the 1st day of April, 2010 at 2:00 P.M. at the Office of the Administrator, 122 West 25th Street, Herschler Building, 2nd Floor East, Cheyenne, Wyoming, 82002. The Department of Administration and Information, Procurement Section, will award the proposed contract to the Bidder determined by the Procurement Section, Administration and Information, to have provided the most responsive and responsible bid. The successful Bidder will be required to enter into and sign a contract with the State. Opened bids shall be available for public review after the contract has been awarded.

The State of Wyoming shall have the power to reject any and all bids or waive any informality in same. No bidder will be allowed to withdraw his/her bid for a period of forty-five (45) days or until the successful bidder has entered into a contract with the State of Wyoming.

The State of Wyoming hereby notifies all prospective bidders it will affirmatively assure that Small, Minority, and Women owned businesses will be afforded full and equal opportunity to submit proposals in response to this invitation and are specifically encouraged to do so. The State of Wyoming further assures that it will not discriminate against anyone on the grounds of sex, race, religion, national origin or disability in consideration for an award.

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The State of Wyoming further notifies all prospective bidders that this bid is being let in accordance with: Wyoming Statutes § 16-6-101 through 16-6-103, 16-6-111, and 16-6-201 through 16-6-206 which provides for preferences for resident contractors and laborers; and Wyoming Statutes § 35-11-1209 which provides AML shall not issue a contract unless the bidder meets certain eligibility requirements.
