DEQ encourages public participation at Small Business Panel Meeting

Casper, WY –The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality Small Business Compliance Advisory Panel (CAP) will meet in Casper on Tuesday, December 14, 2010 at the McMurry Training Center, 2220 N Bryan Stock Trail, beginning at 9 a.m.

The panel will receive presentations on a wide range of environmental issues from various members of the DEQ staff. This information will be focused on issues affecting small businesses, municipalities and other small government entities in Wyoming.

According to Dan Clark, Ombudsman and head of the DEQ Small Business Environmental Assistance Program, the panel is comprised of community and business leaders from across Wyoming. The role of the CAP is to provide advice to the Department on ways to improve the service provided to small businesses throughout the state.

“We provide assistance related to permitting, compliance with environmental rules and regulations, and ways to further improve environmental performance through pollution prevention,” added Clark.

Public participation is invited on these subjects, as are questions about any other environmental issues affecting small businesses in Wyoming.
