Windsor Energy Group has contracted Terracon Consultants, Inc., of Billings, MT to complete a subsurface exploration program intended to determine whether groundwater was impacted with natural gas and condensate as a result of the release that occurred at the Crosby well site. The subsurface exploration program is being conducted concurrent with the on-going sampling of residential drinking water wells, Line Creek, and groundwater springs. The subsurface exploration program commenced on August 25 and consists of drilling monitoring wells in areas surrounding the Crosby well site. Samples of soil, bedrock, and groundwater will be collected and submitted for laboratory analysis. The estimated completion date of the subsurface exploration program is September 15. Groundwater samples will be collected from the installed monitoring wells once all the wells are completed and developed. A Report of Investigations (ROI) will be prepared and submitted to Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality once the analytical results for the groundwater have been provided. The ROI will include the present the findings of the subsurface exploration program and will provide recommendations for additional subsurface explorations and/or remedial activities that may be appropriate.
