

## Water and Waste Advisory Board Meeting

June 24, 2011

The Wyoming Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) will meet on June 24, 2011 from 9 AM until 5 PM at the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, 2211 King Blvd, Casper, Wyoming. The public is invited. Comments may be made on matters concerning the Solid and Hazardous Waste Division. The WWAB will not be receiving comments on the matter concerning the Water Quality Division as the purpose of this portion of the meeting is for approval of modifications to Water Quality Division Rules and Regulations of Chapter 5. The comment period for this rule ended March 21, 2011.

**Water Quality Division** - Beginning at 9:00AM the WWAB will consider, discuss, and make recommendations regarding modifications to Water Quality Division Rules and Regulations of Chapter 5.

**Solid and Hazardous Waste Division** – At the conclusion of the Water Quality Division presentation the WWAB will consider, discuss, and make recommendations regarding grant requests for reimbursement to local governments conducting solid waste landfill monitoring pursuant to W.S. 35-11-521 for the Solid and Hazardous Waste Division.

If not completed at the May 20<sup>th</sup> WWAB meeting the WWAB, in concert with DEQ Solid and Hazardous Waste Division staff, will continue to discuss the criteria which will be used to establish a priority list for municipal landfills that need remediation per Enrolled Senate Act No. 58 of the sixty-first legislature of the State of Wyoming 2011 General Session.
